Then turn right off feeder and proceed to the stop sign, turn left on Scarborough and go past the strip shopping center to the next stop sign. The building is on the right in the next block.

<u>Coming from the South</u>: Take the Gladstell Street exit off I-45 North and proceed on the feeder but do not go under the overpass. Turn right off feeder and proceed to the stop sign, turn left onto Gladstell, and go over the Interstate to the stop sign. Turn left at stop sign onto Scarborough and go past the strip shopping center to the next stop sign. The building is on the right in the next block.
