
This year we have a new meeting place! See the map on the back page if you need directions.

A Tribute

In Memory of Marvin James Williams Nov. 22, 1922-Nov. 8, 2005 by Beverly Roche

Marvin was a career officer in the US Air Force and retired as a Lt. Colonel after 22 years of service. While there he flew a fighter plane during WW II, and later flew jet fighter planes and a bomber.

After the service he lived in Apple Valley, California, where he met and married the love of his life, Elizabeth, and adopted her four sons Donovan, Dennis, David and Daniel.. While in the service he was a distinguished marksman and a member of the United States Shooting Team. While in California he joined The Elks and also became a member of the Apple Valley Gun Club.

On April 15, 1987, Marvin and Elizabeth moved to Texas and bought a house in Panorama Village. There he joined the American Legion Post #618, the Disabled American Veterans, the Panorama Country Club, the Panorama Lions Club, the Senior Friends, and the Coushatta Camellia Society. He and Elizabeth loved to dance and were often seen at the Friendship Center Senior Dances and the Senior Prom held at the Convention Center.

Marvin Williams was a good friend to all and will be missed by those who knew him.




