De-budding CamelliasBy Frank Ohrt

It's late summer (or, mid-summer, if you count the first half of October). It may seem too early to do anything but water your camellias, but they should be starting to show swollen flower buds. As soon as they are about a half inch long, you can start de-budding.

De-budding is the practice of removing excess camellia buds from your plants. This will let the plant put more energy into fewer and bigger flowers. It also lets the remaining buds develop into full-sized blooms without being squashed by 2, 3, or more other buds trying to open in the same space.

It's pretty easy. If there are more than one bud on the tip of a twig, choose one that is pointed up/out from the leaves, and gently twist off the others. You can also remove any that are coming off the side of a twig, and any that are crowded down in the middle of your bush. If your plant has a lot of buds, you may want to remove as many as half of them.

However, if you plan to "gibb" your blooms, leave two on each twig tip, so you can remove one later and apply the gibberellic acid to the remaining bud cup.

Meanwhile, keep your camellias watered and mulched. Fall is coming, but it's not here yet.
