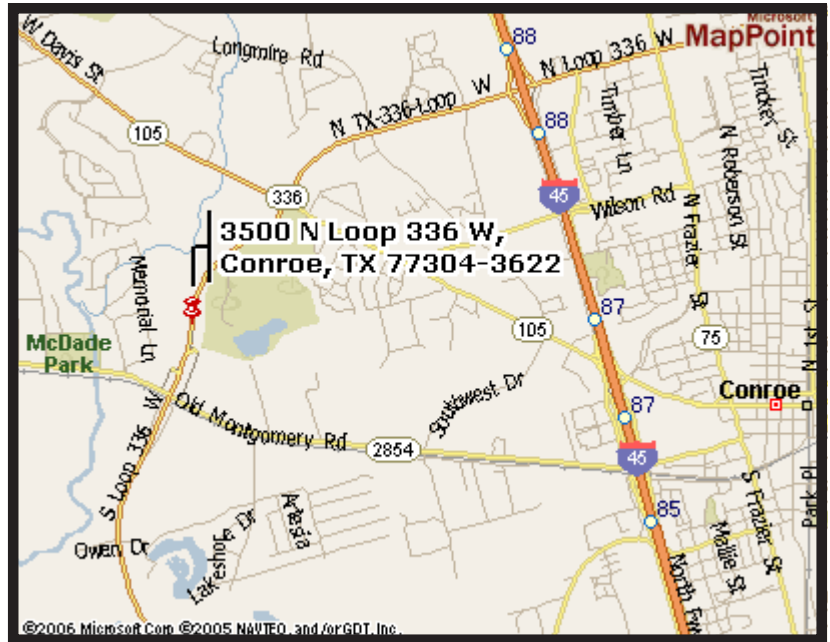


Coushatta Camellia Society loves its NEW meeting place!
