#### **TEXAS CAMELLIA SHOW**

The Coushatta Camellia Society in partnership with the East Texas Camellia Society and the Houston Camellia Society are sponsoring the first Texas Camellia Show in Huntsville, TX. on February 23, 2008. This Texas Camellia Show will be very similar to the Conroe Show and it will need a similar amount of volunteers to make this a successful event.

We kick off activities with our Show set up on Friday, the 22th at 2 PM at the West Hill Mall, Community Center room, in Huntsville. Directions: From I-45 exit to Hwy 190E and Hwy 30, go West about one block and turn left (South) into the Mall parking area. As you travel South along the East side of the Mall, the main entrance is near the center of the Mall. Enter here and take a left at the circle inside the Mall. The Community Center Room will be on your right about a hundred feet after the left turn.

Note for Morris and Oscar: We will need to get CCS permission to use all the hardware (table cloths, signs, etc.) that we use at our Conroe Show and we need someone to bring all this stuff to Huntsville. We will also need to get a key to the back door of the Community Center Room so we can open it early Saturday morning.

On Saturday morning, the back door to the Community Room will be opened for bloom exhibitors at 7 AM. Bloom preparation and set out will be from 7–10:30 AM. We will place a sign at the back entrance on the West side of the Mall for exhibitors to bring their blooms into the Community Center Room easily. Members will be available to assist

exhibitors get their blooms placed in the Show. A lunch will be provided in the Mall next to the Community Room for our volunteers from 10:30-11:30 am for judges, clerks, and members of the three sponsoring Societies.
